


Nurses MC Nashville 25-26 Goals

- 33% of students score proficient or advanced on EOC assessments in ELA 1, Algebra 1, and Biology
- 85% staff and students return for the 26/27 school year.
- 95% average daily attendance for SY 25/26



What is it?

This plan outlines how Nurses MC Nashville will strengthen family engagement to support student learning. We value families as equal partners in improving achievement and provide opportunities for involvement through activities and events at school and home.

How is it revised?

This plan will be reviewed annually with families and through ongoing feedback via online forms, surveys, and meetings. Input collected throughout the year helps update the policy, compact, and budget for the next school year.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Nurses MC Nashville will provide full opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English, with disabilities, and of migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan is included in the student handbook and given to all students. As a reminder, we will email the plan to all families in August before the scheduled Open House event. The plan will also be posted on the school website and social media. Families can also retrieve a copy of the plan in the front office of the school.

What is Title I?

Nurses MC Nashville is identified as a Title I school as part of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title I schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written parent and family engagement policy.

Parent and Family Engagement School- Parent Compacts

Nurses MC Nashville believes that family engagement means the participation of parents and family members in regular two-way, and meaningful communication involving student academic learning and other school activities, including ensuring:

Nurses MC Nashville is Branching Out!

Nurses MC Nashville will take the following measures to empower and support parents and family members as an important foundation of our school in order to strengthen the school and reach our goals.

We will strive to:

- Ensure that all information related to school and family programs, meetings, and other activities is published in both English, Spanish and Arabic; posted on the school website; and included in the monthly school newsletter for all families.
- Provide monthly trainings for staff during their planning periods on strategies to improve communication with families and ideas to increase family engagement in reading and math for our students outside of the classroom. Staff will also share promising practices during regularly scheduled faculty meetings.
- Provide necessary materials and handouts for parents at conferences, meetings, and activities to help parents work with their child to improve their child's achievement.
- Partner with higher education, healthcare institutions, college and career ready resources or organizations, parent resource centers, or other programs (as applicable) to help prepare parents and their children for successful school transitioning.
- Share information in English, Spanish, and Arabic on the school blog and in the school newsletter for families to understand the school's academic standards and assessments as well as the ways families can monitor their child's progress and work with educators.
- Communicate with all families and the community on a regular basis regarding school-wide events and activities, through phone messages, our website, social media, and flyers.
- Work with our families to develop relevant trainings and helpful presentations to educate our staff on the importance of parent and family engagement and how to support student learning.
