Results are used to inform instruction, monitor language development, and support appropriate placement and services for students. Assessments are administered during the school day in accordance with state guidelines.</p>	<p>Individual Student Reports (ISRs) are distributed to students and families in the fall following spring testing.</p> <p>Parent Access: Families receive Individual Student Reports and may request additional information or clarification from the school as needed.</p>
<p>Pre ACT 9/10 9th and 10th grade</p>	<p>March 31st</p>	<p>The PreACT is a college readiness assessment that provides an early indicator of student progress toward college and career readiness benchmarks. Results are used to guide academic</p>	<p>Score reports are provided to students and families once released by the testing provider.</p> <p>Families receive individual student score reports and may access additional resources and explanations through the ACT.</p>
